Change to Cybercom's nomination committee

Cybercom's second-largest shareholder, Accendo Capital, has informed the company that it has reduced its shareholding in Cybercom. Since Accendo Capital is no longer among the three largest shareholders in Cybercom, Accendo Capital's representative is leaving Cybercom's nomination committee.

A new member to replace Accendo Capital's representative will be appointed and announced through a press release as soon as possible once the new rights issue has been completed.
